Starting in the fall of 2018, we present two or three films monthly in the Mark Painter Screening Room. Operated by volunteers who care deeply about cinema, the Garfield continues the nineteen-year CWC tradition of offering high quality documentaries, shorts, narrative fiction, foreign language titles and specialty programs including festivals and classics – focusing on important films that normally bypass Cincinnati.

Other uses include hosting for area filmmakers and festivals, community groups, public forums and occasional live performances.
